A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF RIO BLANCO COUNTY, COLORADO, ESTABLISHING THE 2022 OBSERVED LEGAL HOLIDAYS FOR RIO BLANCO COUNTY GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado, has been requested to designate the legal holidays to be observed by Rio Blanco County Government for the calendar year 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado, that:

The following legal holidays shall be observed by Rio Blanco County Government for 2022:

January 17, 2022 Martin Luther King Jr. Day
February 21, 2022 Presidents Day
May 30, 2022 Memorial Day
July 4, 2022 Independence Day
September 5, 2022 Labor Day
November 11, 2022 Veterans Day
November 24, 2022 Thanksgiving Day
December 26, 2022 Christmas

Additional days as designated by the Board of County Commissioners:

November 25, 2022 day after Thanksgiving
Two days to be taken between January 2, 2022 and December 31, 2022 and any other day as designated by the Board of County Commissioners.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado declares that it would have adopted this Resolution and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion herein, despite the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions would be declared invalid or unconstitutional.
