

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-07

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF RIO BLANCO COUNTY, COLORADO, AUTHORIZING THE RIO BLANCO COUNTY ASSESSOR TO REVIEW AND APPROVE ABATEMENT PETITIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000.00) OR LESS

WHEREAS, by Colorado Revised Statutes, Assessors in Colorado historically could review and approve abatement petitions in an amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or less per account; and

WHEREAS, C.R.S. 39-1-113(1.5) states that upon authorization by the Board of County Commissioners, the assessor may review petitions for abatement or refund and settle by written mutual agreement any such petition for abatement or refund in an amount of Ten Thousand Dollars, (\$10,000.00) or less per tract, parcel, or lot of land or per schedule of personal property raised; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado believes it is in the best interests of the citizens of Rio Blanco County to authorize the Rio Blanco County Assessor to review and settle abatement petitions which are in an amount of Ten Thousand Dollars, (\$10,000.00) or less per account;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF RIO BLANCO COUNTY, COLORADO:

- 1) The Rio Blanco County Assessor is hereby authorized to review and settle by a written mutual agreement with a Petitioner, all abatement petitions in the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars, (\$10,000.00) or less per account without further review and approval by this Board.
- 2) The effective date of this authorization is February 8, 2022 and applies to all abatement petitions filed after January 1, 2022.
- 3) The Board finds, determines, and declares that this Resolution is necessary and proper to provide for the safety, preserve the health, promote the prosperity, and improve the order, comfort, welfare and convenience of Rio Blanco County and the inhabitants thereof.

4) If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado, declares that it would have adopted this Resolution and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion herein, despite the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions would be declared invalid or unconstitutional.
