

RESOLUTION NO. 2013 - 29

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF RIO BLANCO COUNTY, COLORADO DESIGNATING ADDITIONAL PORTIONS OF CERTAIN RIO BLANCO COUNTY ROADS WHERE THE USE OF UNLICENSED OFF HIGHWAY VEHICLES AND SNOWMOBILES IS ALLOWED

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado (BOCC) has determined that the use of Off Highway Vehicles (OHV) and snowmobiles within the unincorporated areas of Rio Blanco County should be allowed on designated Rio Blanco County Roads (County Roads), subject to the conditions, regulations, and restrictions established in Resolution No. 2011-43 adopted by the BOCC on December 12, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the BOCC designated certain portions of County Roads where the use of OHV was allowed by Resolution No. 2014-14 adopted by the BOCC on May 14, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the BOCC by this Resolution intends to specifically designate additional portions of certain County Roads within the County Road system where the use of OHV and snowmobiles will be allowed; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of this Resolution is necessary and proper to provide for the safety, preserve the health, promote the prosperity, and improve the order, comfort, welfare and convenience of the County and the inhabitants thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado as follows:

1. Those portions of the Rio Blanco County Roads listed on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference are hereby declared to be available and open to use by OHV and snowmobiles subject to the regulations, restrictions and conditions set forth in this Resolution and in Resolution No. 2011-43.
2. The Rio Blanco County Road and Bridge Supervisor shall appropriately place cautionary signs, including in some cases lighted signs, at all locations where regular vehicular traffic and OHV will be sharing the County Roads.
3. All other Rio Blanco County Roads and/or portions thereof not listed on Exhibit A are closed to the use of OHV and snowmobiles.
4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado, declares that it would have adopted this Resolution and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion herein, despite

the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions would be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

- 5. This Resolution shall remain in effect for a period of two years from its date of adoption unless extended by further resolution of the BOCC.
