January 1, 2014 New Year's Day
February 17, 2014 Presidents Day
May 26, 2014 Memorial Day
July 4, 2014 Independence Day
September 1, 2014 Labor Day
November 11, 2014 Veterans Day
November 27, 2014 Thanksgiving Day
December 25, 2014 Christmas Day

Additional days as designated by the Board of County Commissioners:

August 4, 2014 – Colorado Day
November 28, 2014
December 26, 2014

One additional day to be taken between January 1, 2014 and December 31, 2014 and any other day as designated by the Board of County Commissioners.




