A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF RIO BLANCO COUNTY, COLORADO, LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2013, TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF PICEANCE CREEK PEST CONTROL DISTRICT FOR THE COUNTY OF RIO BLANCO, COLORADO, FOR THE 2014 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado, has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 12, 2013; and

WHEREAS, said adopted budget incorporates the separate legal entity of the Piceance Creek Pest Control District also located within Rio Blanco County, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating purposes of the Piceance Creek Pest Control District from property tax revenue is \$307,153; and

WHEREAS, the 2013 valuation for assessment for the Piceance Creek Pest Control District of Rio Blanco as certified by the County Assessor is \$153,576,350.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado as follows:

Section 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of Piceance Creek Pest Control District during the 2014 budget year, there is hereby levied 2.000 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for the assessment of all taxable property within the District for the year 2013.

Section 2. That for information purposes, the mill levy set forth in Section 1 above shall be directed to the Weed & Pest Control Fund for specific use by the activities of the Piceance Creek Pest Control District only.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution is for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado declares that it would have adopted this Resolution and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion herein, despite the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions would be declared invalid or unconstitutional.
