A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
RIO BLANCO COUNTY, COLORADO, ESTABLISHING THE 2018 OBSERVED LEGAL HOLIDAYS
FOR RIO BLANCO COUNTY GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado, has been requested to designate the legal holidays to be observed by Rio Blanco County Government for the calendar year 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado, that:

The following legal holidays shall be observed by Rio Blanco County Government for 2018:

January 1, 2018 New Year's Day
January 15, 2018, Martin Luther King Jr. Day
February 19, 2018 Presidents Day
May 28, 2018 Memorial Day
July 4, 2018 Independence Day
September 3, 2018 Labor Day
November 12, 2018 Veterans Day
November 22, 2018 Thanksgiving Day
December 25, 2018 Christmas

Additional days as designated by the Board of County Commissioners:

August 1, 2018, Colorado Day
November 23, 2018, day after Thanksgiving

One additional day to be taken between January 2, 2018 and December 31, 2018 and any other day as designated by the Board of County Commissioners.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado declares that it would have adopted this Resolution and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion herein, despite the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions would be declared invalid or unconstitutional.
