

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-32

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF RIO BLANCO COUNTY, COLORADO, LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2017, TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE COUNTY OF RIO BLANCO, COLORADO, FOR THE 2018 BUDGET YEAR.**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado, has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 11, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating purposes from property tax revenue is \$7,450,039; and

WHEREAS, the 2017 valuation for assessment for the County of Rio Blanco as certified by the County Assessor is \$823,208,760.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado as follows:

Section 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of Rio Blanco County during the 2018 budget year, there is hereby levied 9.050 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for the assessment of all taxable property within the County for the year 2017.

Section 2. That for information purposes, the mill levy set forth in Section 1 above shall be broken down as follows:

General Fund	4.445
Road and Bridge Fund	3.500
Human Services Fund	0.250
Public Health Agency Fund	0.155
Capital Expenditures Fund	<u>0.700</u>
Total County Operating Mill Levy	<u>9.050</u>

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution is for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado declares that it would have adopted this Resolution and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion herein, despite the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions would be declared invalid or unconstitutional.
