

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
OF RIO BLANCO COUNTY, COLORADO, ESTABLISHING THE DISTRIBUTION OF  
TITLE I FEDERAL FOREST RESERVE FUND MONEY**

**WHEREAS**, on March 16, 2018, Rio Blanco County, Colorado, received \$296,752.84 of Title I Federal Forest Reserve Fund Money for Federal Fiscal Year 2017 based on the 25% payment methodology under the Twenty-Five Percent Fund Act of 1908, and

**WHEREAS**, 30-29-101 Colorado Revised Statute, was amended on May 11, 2009, to require that the discretionary portion of Title I Federal Forest Reserve Fund Money be distributed based upon an agreement between Rio Blanco County and School Districts located within the County; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 10, 2018, an agreement was reached between Rio Blanco County and the School Districts which determined the distribution of the discretionary portion of Title I funds.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
COMMISSIONERS OF RIO BLANCO COUNTY, COLORADO:**


- 1) The Title I Federal Forest Reserve Fund Money discretionary funds received on March 16, 2018 in the total amount of \$296,752.84, shall be distributed as follows: Rio Blanco County Road & Bridge-- \$123,647.02, RE-1 School District-- \$100,347.58, RE-4 School District-- \$72,273.19 and RE-3-JT School District-- \$485.05.
- 2) A certified copy of this Resolution shall be delivered to the County Treasurer of Rio Blanco County, Colorado.
- 3) Upon receiving the certified copy of this Resolution, the County Treasurer shall distribute the Title I Federal Reserve Fund Money as described in this Resolution.



Dear School Superintendents:

Beginning in 2010, the process for distribution of Title I Federal Forest Reserve Fund money changed. Counties and School Districts must agree on the percentage of distribution. In 2011, an agreement was reached to distribute the 50% discretionary portion of Title I funds on a percentage basis of 33.33 to the County's Road & Bridge Fund and 66.67 to the 3 school districts, based on individual pupil count. Rio Blanco County would like to propose the same percentage distribution for 2018 (of 2017 federal fiscal year monies).

RE-1 School District with pupil count:	682.7	\$ 100,347.58
RE-4 School District with pupil count:	491.7	\$ 72,273.19
RE-3-JT School District with pupil count:	3.3	\$ <u>485.05</u>
Total School Distribution:		\$ 172,105.82

The Board of County Commissioners must sign a formal resolution before disbursement can occur. A response from each school district is necessary and would be appreciated by April 12<sup>th</sup>.
