

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-19**RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE ENACTMENT OF ANY LEGISLATION THAT WOULD INFRINGE UPON THE RIGHT OF THE PEOPLE TO KEEP AND BEAR ARMS AND CONSIDERING SUCH LAWS TO BE UNCONSTITUTIONAL AND BEYOND LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS, the Right of the People to Keep and Bear Arms is guaranteed as an Individual Right under the Second Amendment to the United States Constitution and under the Constitution of the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the Right of the People to Keep and Bear Arms for defense of Life, Liberty, and Property is regarded as an Inalienable Right by the People of Rio Blanco County, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the People of Rio Blanco County, Colorado derive economic benefit from all safe forms of firearms usage, including recreation, hunting, and shooting conducted within Rio Blanco County, Colorado, allowable under the United State Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado; being elected to represent the People of Rio Blanco County and being duly sworn by their Oath of Office to uphold the United States Constitution and the Constitution of the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution is in the best interests of the health, safety, morals, convenience, order, prosperity and welfare of the citizens of Rio Blanco County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF RIO BLANCO, COLORADO:


- 1) That the People of Rio Blanco County, Colorado, do hereby oppose the enactment of any legislation that would infringe upon the Right of the People to keep and bear arms and consider suchy laws to be unconstitutional and beyond lawful Legislative Authority.
- 2) That the Clerk and Recorder of Rio Blanco County is hereby directed to prepare and deliver copies of this Resolution to all members of the Colorado General Assembly and to the Office of the Governor.
- 3) That if the Government of the State of Colorado shall infringe upon the inalienable rights granted by the Second Amendment, Rio Blanco County shall become a "sanctuary city" for all firearms unconstitutionally prohibited by the government of the State of Colorado, in that Rio Blanco County will prohibit its employees from enforcing the unconstitutional actions of the State of Colorado government.
