

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-09

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF RIO BLANCO COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes, Section 30-11-107(1)(n), the Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County ("Board") is authorized to create such offices as the Board deems required for the efficient management of the business and concerns of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board is authorized to make appointments of the offices so created and to prescribe duties to be performed by such appointees; and

**WHEREAS**, to further the efficient and effective management of County affairs, the Board desires to establish the office of Managing Commissioner.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado as follows:

1. The position of Managing Commissioner is hereby created. There may be more than one Managing Commissioner.
2. Each Commissioner is hereby appointed as the Managing Commissioner and shall be responsible for the oversight, supervision and serve as the point of contact for the assigned departments as prescribed in the attached organizational chart, Exhibit "A". Provided, however, for those Departments run by elected officials (e.g. Sheriff, Clerk, Assessor) the Managing Commissioner shall serve as a liaison between the other elected official and the Board of County Commissioners.
3. The Board of County Commissioners may review the direction and actions of a Managing Commissioner from time to time in order to determine that the Board of Commissioner's policies and directions are being followed or for whatever other reason the Board of County Commissioners deems appropriate.
4. The duties of the Managing Commissioner shall include informing the other Commissioners on a regular basis of the activities of the departments being supervised by the Managing Commissioner.
5. Provided, further, this Resolution and the creation of the position of Managing Commissioner is not intended to nor does it abrogate the law that the Board of County Commissioners must act as a board and that no individual commissioner may bind the County. Rather, this Resolution creates a position which is a mechanism by which the Board of County Commissioners may effectively fulfill its obligation to oversee the operations of Rio Blanco County.

The effective date hereof shall be the date of the adoption of this Resolution.
