NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado, that:

The following legal holidays shall be observed by Rio Blanco County Government for 2020:

January 1, 2020 New Year's Day
January 20, 2020, Martin Luther King Jr. Day
February 17, 2020 Presidents Day
May 25, 2020 Memorial Day
July 3, 2020 Independence Day
September 7, 2020 Labor Day
November 11, 2020 Veterans Day
November 26, 2020 Thanksgiving Day
December 25, 2020 Christmas

Additional days as designated by the Board of County Commissioners:


November 27, 2020 day after Thanksgiving
Two days to be taken between January 2, 2020 and December 31, 2020 and any other day as designated by the Board of County Commissioners.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado declares that it would have adopted this Resolution and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion herein, despite the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions would be declared invalid or unconstitutional.
