

RESOLUTION 2020- 05

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF RIO BLANCO COUNTY, COLORADO, VESTING JURISDICTION OVER PLUMBING PERMIT AND INSPECTIONS TO THE COLORADO STATE PLUMBING BOARD

WHEREAS, the Rio Blanco County Building Department, has previously provided plumbing permit and inspection services within the boundaries of the unincorporated areas of Rio Blanco County; and

WHEREAS, the County no longer employs a licensed plumber capable of reviewing and inspecting plumbing permits for the installation, remodel, or additions to new or existing plumbing structures; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the health, safety, morals, convenience, order, prosperity and welfare of the citizens of Rio Blanco County, Colorado for the Colorado State Plumbing Board to take jurisdiction over all plumbing permits and inspections within the unincorporated areas of Rio Blanco County, Colorado.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF RIO BLANCO COUNTY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

1. All requests for plumbing permits and inspections will be referred to the Colorado State Plumbing Board.
2. The Colorado State Plumbing Board will have jurisdiction for plumbing permitting and inspections within the unincorporated areas of Rio Blanco County for the following:
 - All potable water supplies and distribution piping
 - All plumbing fixtures and traps
 - All drainage and vent pipes
 - All building drains, gas, and vacuum systems
 - Manufactured/Modular/Mobile homes for water, sewer and gas connections
3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Board of County Commissioners of Rio Blanco County, Colorado declares that it would have adopted this Resolution and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion herein, despite the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions would be declared invalid or unconstitutional.
