BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
SPECIAL MEETING

The Board met at 12:32 p.m. in special session at the RBC Courthouse, 555 Main St., Meeker, CO. Chairman Gary Moyer, Commissioner Ty Gates, Rio Blanco County Attorney Donald Steerman, Board Assistant Vicky Edwards, and Clerk to the Board Boots M. Campbell attended in person. Commissioner Jeff Rector participated by phone.

Call to order – Pledge of Allegiance: The meeting began with the pledge of allegiance.

Approval of the Agenda

Commissioner Rector moved to approve the October 5, 2021 agenda with no changes. Commissioner Gates seconded. Roll call vote: Gates-Aye, Rector-Aye, Moyer-Aye.

BUSINESS

Commissioner Gates moved to approve a specific Waiver of the Attorney Client Privilege regarding a letter written by the County Attorney to the Board of County Commissioners dated September 30, 2021, summarizing whether the Hostile Work Place Investigation made findings of a Hostile Work Environment. Commissioner Rector seconded. Roll call vote: Rector-Aye, Moyer-Aye, Gates-Aye.

It was noted that the investigation findings were being held by Attorney Steerman as an attorney work product and since there are items in the report that potentially could necessitate further investigation, or other agency response may be warranted, the report cannot be released at this time.
